### Description of Categories:

The Oregon Hearth, Patio & Barbecue Association represents and promotes the interests of the hearth, patio and barbecue products industries. Hearth products include fireplaces, stoves, decorative and functional accessories, fuels and all other hearth related products.

Hearth, Patio & Barbecue Association (HPBA) membership is available to manufacturers and distributors of any product and services sold through the hearth, HVAC, casual furniture, or barbecue distribution network and to those that manufacture or distribute any products promoted at HPBA's annual trade show. Companies must join OHPBA/HPBA in the membership category that represents the **largest proportion** of their business.

### Membership Category (check one):

- Retailer:** Any company that sells products directly to consumers.
- Additional Retail Store:** A retail store whose parent store or corporate office *already* has a membership with OHPBA.
- New Member:** Retail, service or manufacturer's rep new to the association or who have not been a member for more than five years.
- Service:** Hearth appliance installers, gas service technicians, chimney sweeps, or individuals that specialize in chimney and appliance installation and service.
- Manufacturer's Representatives:** Independent manufacturer's agents or company sales agents and/or representatives.
- Non-Profit:** Associations, universities or other not-for-profit organizations.
- Informational Member:** A member **holding a membership** with another HPBA affiliate such as **a company doing business in the same market** as a neighboring affiliate, like NWHPA. This category receives newsletters and event discounts.
- Distributors:** Companies that sell and distribute products for resale to consumers, contract installers and homebuilders.
- Associates:** Companies or individuals that do not fall into any of the above membership categories: gas utilities, testing laboratories, consultants, insurers, and financial firms.

**Manufacturers:** (contact HPBA directly). Any company that manufactures, brands or imports appliances, fuel or any other hearth-related products sold or distributed through the hearth, patio/casual furniture, or barbecue distribution network, or those that manufacture any product promoted at HPBA's annual trade show.

**Note:** For U.S. Federal income tax purposes membership dues may be deductible as business expenses, not as charitable contributions. The Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1993 requires OHPBA to inform each member that an estimated 15% of dues will be allocable for lobbying expenditures as defined by the Act and therefore are not deductible as business expenses.



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
